

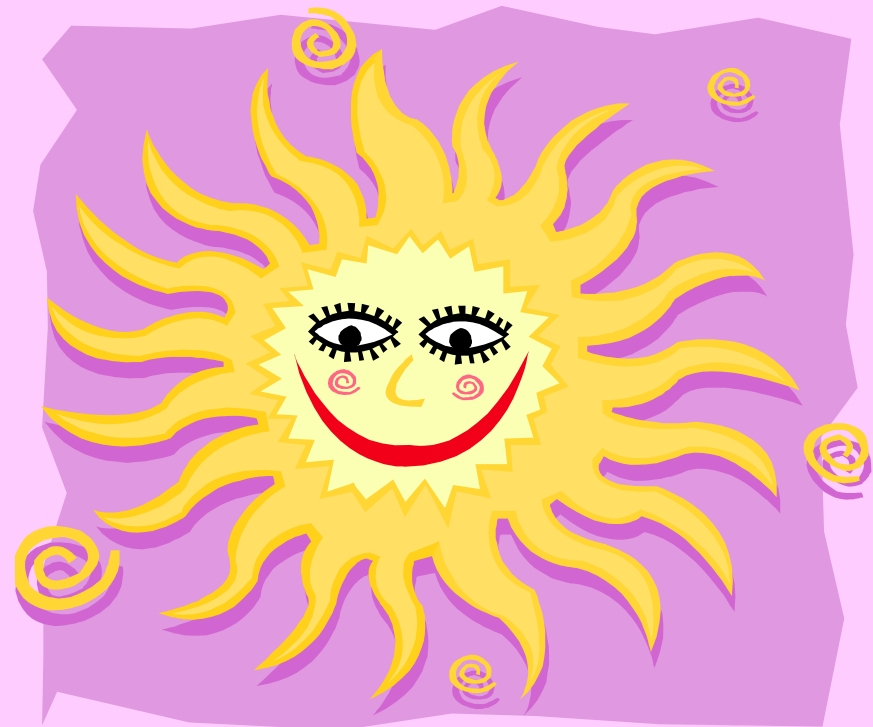
# Exploring Values

In the following slides, you will be asked to choose one value over the other.

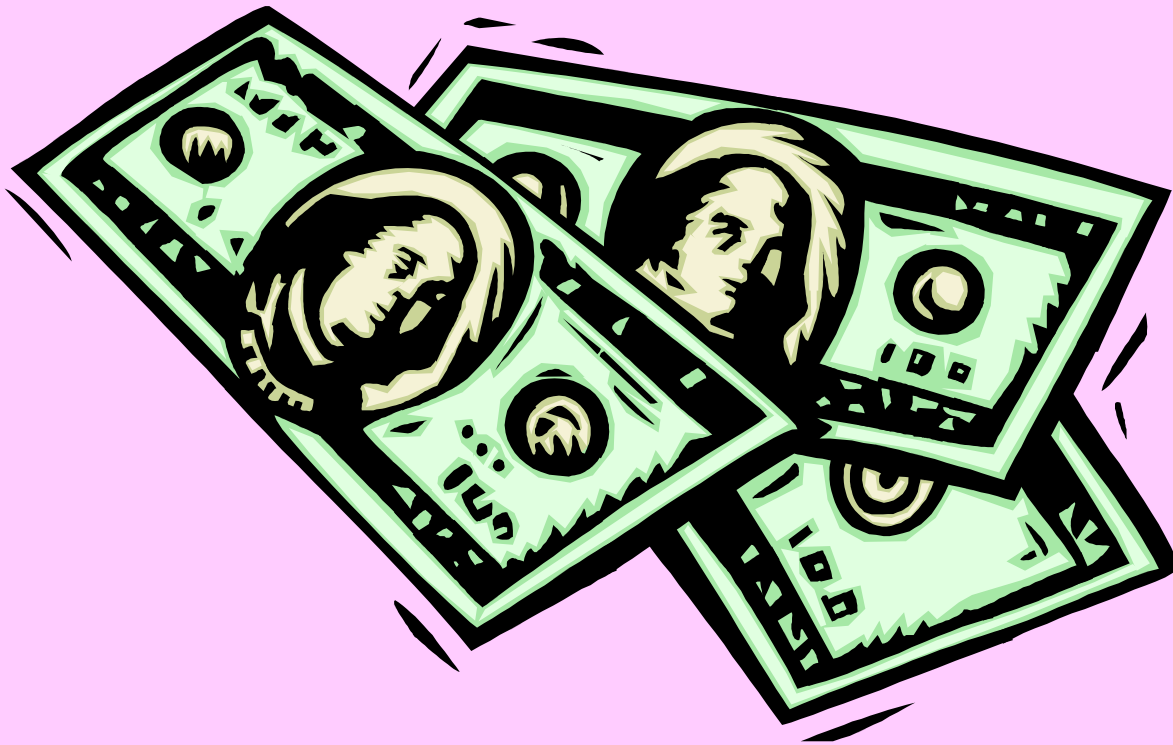
If you could have one of these, just by wishing, which would you wish for?

Who will make notes

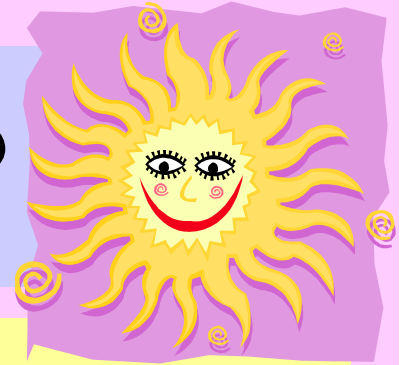
### A chairperson

# Power or Pleasure?



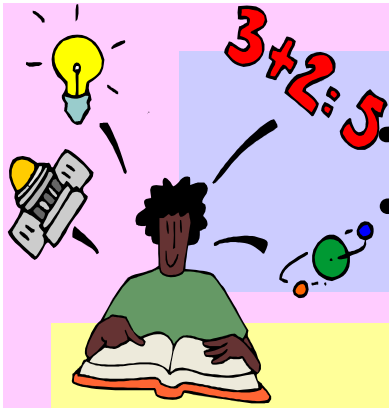
- What is power?

- Can you be powerful without being wealthy?



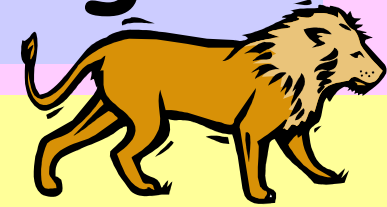
# Wealth or Friendship?



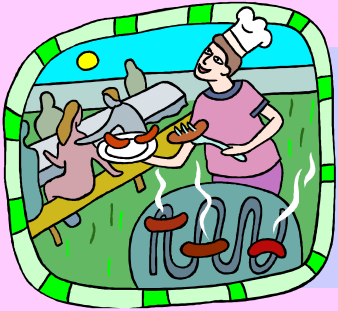
- What is wealth?

- Can you be courageous without being at all intelligent?
- Is it courageous to attempt something dangerous that has no chance of success?
- Are you courageous if you aren't scared at all?
- Is it intelligent not to be scared?
- Do you need courage to be intelligent?
- Do you need courage to use intelligence?
- Is it worse to be stupid or cowardly?



# Security or Fame?



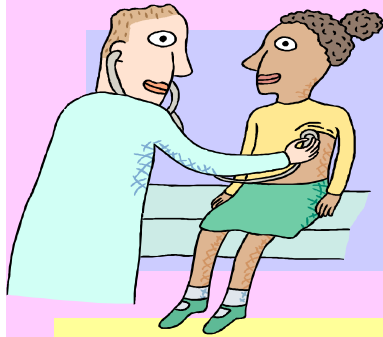
- What counts as fame?

- Can you be famous to 27 people?
- Do people outside your own community have to know about you to make you famous?
- Can you be famous for anything, or only some kinds of things?
- Can fame and security go together?
- Would you rather be without fame or without security?
- Why is security important?



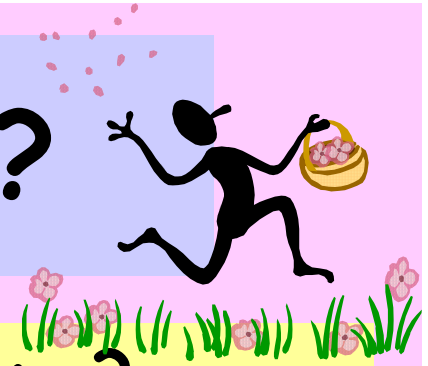
# Freedom or Fairness?



- Why is freedom important?
- What is freedom?
- What would you do if you were perfectly free?
- What would life be like if everyone were perfectly free to do what they wanted?
- Can freedom and fairness conflict?
- Can freedom and fairness go together?
- Could fairness reduce your freedom?
- Could fairness increase your freedom?

- Are there things you would rather not know the truth about?
- Could you be happy while not knowing the truth about something?
- Would you rather be unhappy and know the truth, or be happy and be deceived?
